- Demand for RNs is projected to grow more than 35 percent.
- The **San Joaquin Valley** is projected to experience a shortage of between 6,191 and 9,944 nurses by 2030.

“Recommendation V. Provide transformative learning opportunities that prepare nurses for evolving roles in rapidly changing interprofessional practice environments.
